



Battle of Monmouth Historic Trail Helpful Information

On behalf of the Order of the Arrow Na Tsi Lodge 71, we welcome you to our Battle of Monmouth Historic Trail. We hope you enjoy your hike and hike safely through our towns.

Before your Trail Hike

- This trail is NOT a loop. Have vehicles ready at the end of the trail before leaving Lawrence Lodge. Cars may be parked behind the Monmouth county court house.
- Please be on time to the trail orientation at Lawrence lodge.
- If you choose to eat lunch at Monmouth Battlefield State Park please note this is a carry-in-carry out state park.
- Please follow Leave No Trace guidelines as you will be walking in through some residential areas.
- If you chose to purchase patches or medals, please buy them before you leave the Trail Orientation room as no one will be available upon your return. We can take cash or check.
- Please remember to drink water on the trail. Water is available on the front of the lodge

On the Trail (Using the "Battle of Monmouth Scout Trail" Map

- (Marker 01 towards Marker 02) When you leave the camp grounds, you will turn right onto 527-A/Iron Ore Road. Bear Right on Mount Vernon (One Way Street) and follow to 527-A again. Left on Conover. Left on Park. Stop in front of the lake. This is the first question to be answered which will put you almost in Downtown Englishtown
- (Marker 07) There is no name on the Sutfin House. It's currently boarded up and blocked off. It can be seen from the distance
- (Marker 08) Visitor's Center (there is a bathroom and water fountain inside if needed)
- (Marker 09) This is a brick well without a label on it that is found near the intersection of the Railroad Tracks and 522. Weather has done significant damage to this landmark
- (Marker 10) Weather has washed out the bridge after the Craig House. For safety reasons, please backtrack down the dirt road to 522 past the church and cemetery. Go left to continue the hike.

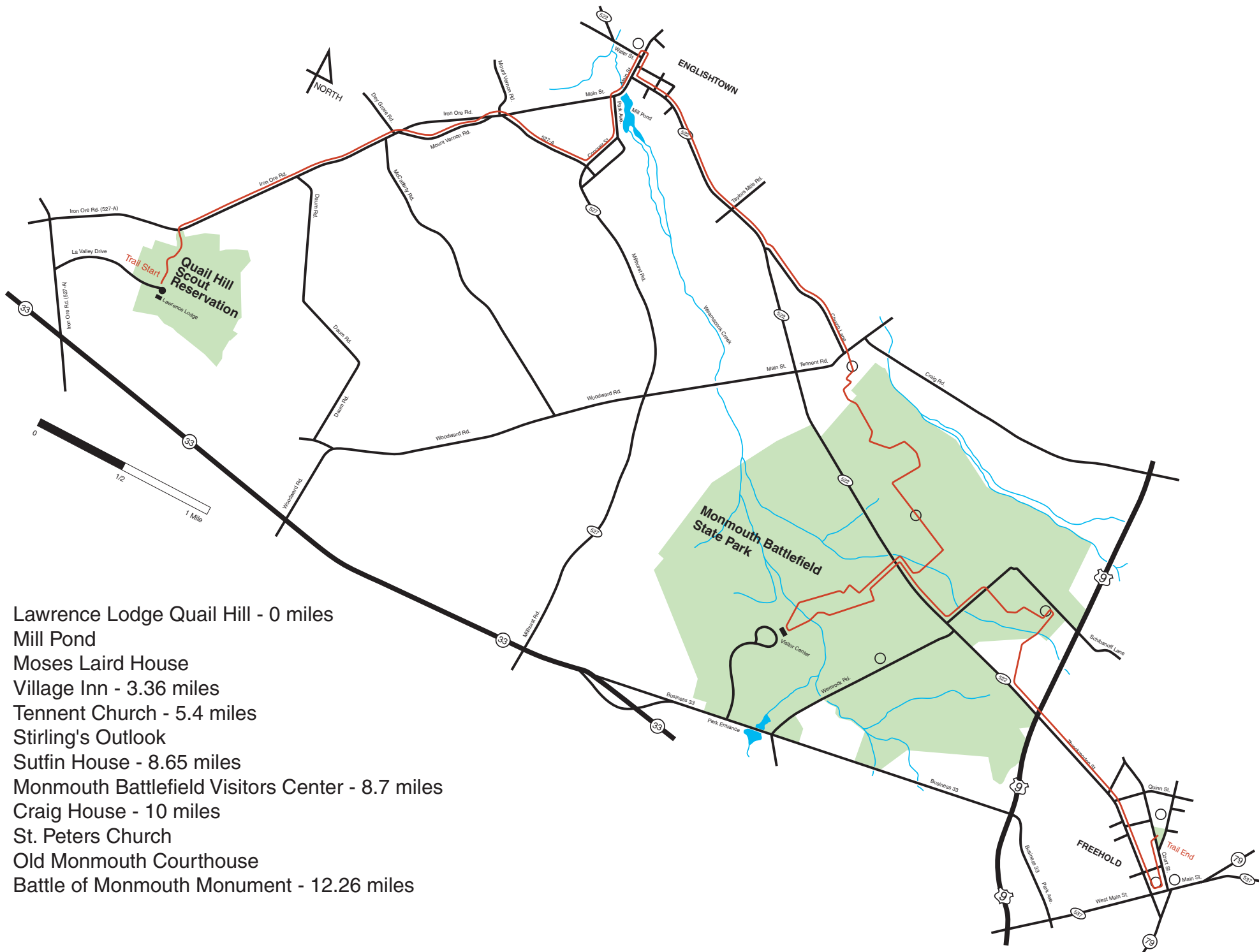
